

Code of Conduct

- Members are responsible for conducting themselves in a moral, lawful and ethical manner, obeying all applicable local, state, provincial, federal civil and criminal laws and regulations. Members should avoid the appearance of any criminal offense or professional misconduct.
- Members shall not discriminate against other members, exhibitors or consumers based on race, religion, nationality, or disability, gender or sexual orientation.
- Members will adhere to the Bylaws and policies of the ICES organization. Members are responsible for promoting the mission, goals and objectives of the ICES organization and not behaving in a manner in conflict with these stated ideals.
- Members shall disclose all relationships that might constitute, or appear to constitute, conflicts of interest.
- Members shall not engage, directly or indirectly, in false or misleading practices.
- Members, in order to maintain and broaden public confidence, shall perform all responsibilities with the highest sense of integrity.
- Members shall avoid defaming one another.
- Members shall not misappropriate the property of others.
