

Sequence of Representative Rotation

The Representative serves-

- from the last day of the Convention from one year until the last day of the convention the next year
- for a two-year term (unless otherwise specified)

Example: The Representative elected in 1999-

- will serve from the last day of the Convention 1999 until the last day of Convention 2000
- is sworn in for the second year of his/her term at Convention 2000 and will serve until the last day of Convention 2001

The Representative will-

- attend the Midyear Meeting and Convention
- promote the Days of Sharing in their state/area/province/country
- keep the Alternates informed at all times

At Convention, the Representative that serves during the year-

- attends the Representatives breakfast
- receives the Representative certificate and medallion or gift, if given
- receives the marker on the state/area/province/country sugar art display table(s), etc.

(Note: If the Representative cannot attend the Convention, he/she is still entitled to the medallion and other recognition as thanks for his/her work during the past year).
